WHEN?

The course will start with an Introductory Day in October 2017 and will spread over two years. Each year will consist of three terms of fortnightly Wednesdays from 10.00 am to 3.00 pm. The first term will be aimed at helping people to discern whether they are called to this work.

There will also be a residential retreat weekend at the end of term 2 and a residential workshop weekend at the start of the second year.
